INVOLVEMENT	Over 125 local businesses partner with United Way to conduct their annual fundraising campaign. Last year, over 538 volunteers assisted the organization.
EFFICIENCY	The administrative rate of 11.1% is significantly lower than the average of 35% recommended by the Charities Review Council.
RESULTS	United Way and its funded partners are working to address the needs in our four impact areas of healthy communities, youth opportunity, financial security, and community resiliency. • Over 29,567 meals served to families and individuals in need • Families saved over \$293,300 in tax prep fees using VITA tax prep • 6,598 individuals received emergency financial assistance Funding supports 39 programs at 31 health and human service agencies across all
	five counties.
IMPACT	United Way internally operates several community impact programs, including West Virginia 211, VITA Tax Preperation, the United for Kids collection, Volunteer HQ, and the Flipside Afterschool program.
RESOURCES	In addition to the annual fundraising camapign, United Way also generated over \$407,000 in grants and sponsorships. Non-financial contributions in the form of in-kind gifts are valued at over \$75,000.
